


Taft's Swimming Team makes a big "splash" when they enter city competition. They are coached by Mr. Joe Kupcinet and during the swimming season practice after school.


SWIMMING TEAMS 1956-57

TAFT SWIM MEET

The Taft Senior Swim team met and sunk the Sullivan High team Wednesday afternoon at Taft's Pool. It was a complete sweep in all events for Taft, who won 48 to 16.

The bellringers for the Taft team were: Kotarek, in the 40 yard freestyle; Peterson, in the 100 yard butterfly; Carson, in the 200 yard freestyle; Rodickin, in the 100 yard backstroke; Waldhier, in the 100 yard freestyle; Ralley, in the 100 yard breaststroke; the team of Rodick, Ralley, Peterson and Bensiger in the 160 yard Mediey newsy and the team of Kotarek, Murray, Waldhier and Carson in the 160 yard freestyle relay. These were all first place winners.

Taft's Junior swim team did not fare quite as well as did their big brothers—they had to settle for three firsts. Miller took the 40 yard butterfly; Litterski the 40 yard backstroke and the team of Litterski, Lassman, Miller and McKenzie in the 160 yard Medley relay. They lost by the narrow margin of 28 to 30.
