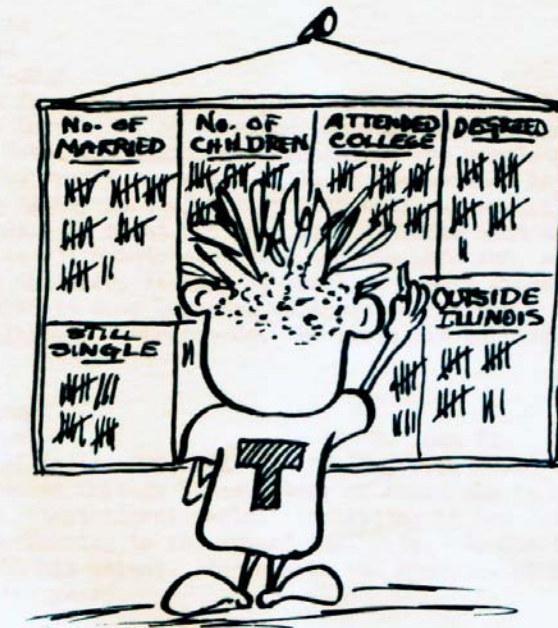

THE PASSAGE OF TIME SINCE OUR GRADUATION HAS PRODUCED SOME INTERESTED STATISTICS. THE FOLLOWING FIGURES INDICATE TO SOME EXTENT THE ACCOMPLISHMENTS OF OUR CLASSMATES OVER THE PAST TEN YEARS.

Out of 302 graduates, 159 have replied. Out of those who replied, 147 are married and 12 remain single. Out of those married, 33 selected fellow Taftites as their mates. Of those, 5 couples married within the class. The marriages have produced a total of 217 children, with boys running ahead of girls at the rate of 115 to 112. Our mathematical brains further reveal the average family size to be 1.48 children.

After graduation 111 (or 69% of those responding) attended college and 58 received degrees. Nine received advanced degrees. Two attended service schools, one at West Point and one at the U. S. Naval Academy. We have 12 Teachers, one Lawyer, 2 Physicians, 2 Dentists, 6 Nurses, 2 Policemen, 6 presently in Military Service, one Minister, one Architect, and one Professional Athlete.
